On 20 March 2015, Cass Sunstein will be appointed Honorary Doctor at Copenhagen Business School and the Department of Intercultural Communication and Management (ICM)

Cass Sunstein is currently the Robert Walmsley University Professor at Harvard and author of hundreds of articles and essays. He is co-author of the bestseller "Nudge: Improving Decisions about Health, Wealth, and Happiness" (2008) and recently published the books "Simpler: The Future of Government" (2013) and "Wiser: Getting beyond groupthink to make groups smarter (with Reid Hastie, 2014).
