# Covering travel and conference costs for international students

The Ministry of Science, Research and the Arts Baden-Württemberg (MWK) provides financial support for student research (including undergraduate and graduate students) at Zeppelin University.

#### Scholarships include

- Travel costs (e.g. return flight to Germany, academic conferences, travel costs to interview partners, project partners)
- Research-related accommodation costs (e.g. for conferences; general living expenses not included)
- Registration fees for conferences
- Working material/ printing costs for presentations on conferences (e.g. posters, surveys); printing costs for bachelor and master thesis are not included
