Subject-Specific Study and Examination Regulations for the one-year Master of Science Study Program Corporate Management & Economics | 1y MSc CME at Zeppelin University dated 22/06/2022

Based on § 70 Para. 6 in conjunction with § 32 Para. 1 of the law governing universities in Baden-Württemberg (State Higher Education Act – LHG) in the version valid on 12/3/2014, the Senate of Zeppelin University has decided upon the following regulations, last amended on 22/06/2022, governing teaching, study and examination regulations of the Master of Science study program Corporate Management & Economics (CME):

§ 1 Study program-specific admissions requirements

Admission to the one-year Master of Science study program in CME is granted to applicants who have obtained a first degree in Economics with 240 ECTS points.

§ 2 Study program objective

The research-oriented one-year CME MSc study program prepares students for a career in academia as well as in the public, non-profit and commercial sectors.

§ 3 Study program structure

- (1) The study program (60 ECTS points) consists of 1 compulsory module (1st & 2nd semesters, 12 ECTS points), 4 elective modules (1st & 2nd semesters, 24 ECTS points), and the master thesis including a thesis defense (2nd semester, 24 ECTS points) (see Appendix 2). Tandem Coaching is a part of the workload in accordance with the ECTS and takes place during semesters 1 and 2.
- (2) Admissions requirements for individual modules are regulated by the respective module description.

§ 4 Elective Modules

- (1) Elective modules can be found in Appendix 2 of these regulations and can be selected depending on individual prior knowledge.
- (2) Depending on prior knowledge students can select all modules of an interdisciplinary subject area and complete this subject area by successfully completing each module in accordance with Appendix 2.
- (3) Elective modules worth 18 ECTS points can be replaced by a student research project within the scope of module 24251 "Elinor-Ostrom-Project".

- (4) An elective module worth 6 ECTS points can be selected from another Zeppelin University master study programs excluding executive programs (multidisciplinary elective module) or from another domestic or foreign university. The latter is subject to approval of a formal request in advance.
- (5) As a rule, students can choose any mandatory and elective modules within the Zeppelin University master study programs that are not included in the student's own program (major) as multidisciplinary elective modules (depending on availability and subject-related admissions requirements), as well as from offered StudentStudies and GlobalStudies.
- (6) A minor in CME is offered to students in other Zeppelin University master study programs.
- (7) Participation in the workshops "Fundamentals of Entrepreneurship" and "Creativity & Performativity" is open to students as an extracurricular activity

§ 5 Authorization of the Examination Committee

The Central Examination Committee is authorized to modify these regulations by notification of the Senate. This does not apply to significant changes concerning the content-related orientation or the structure of the study program.

§ 6 Effective date

- (1)These regulations as amended shall come into force with effect from 22/06/2022.
- (2) They shall apply to students who begin their studies in the Fall Semester 2022 or later.
