Arrival via Bodensee International Airport Friedrichshafen (FDH)

- | Multiple flights from Frankfurt to Friedrichshafen available
- | From FDH you can continue either by bus, rental car or taxi
 - | Bus: Every 10 to 20 minutes heading to the central station (*Stadtbahn*hof)

Depending on which hotel you are staying in:

Buchhorner Hof

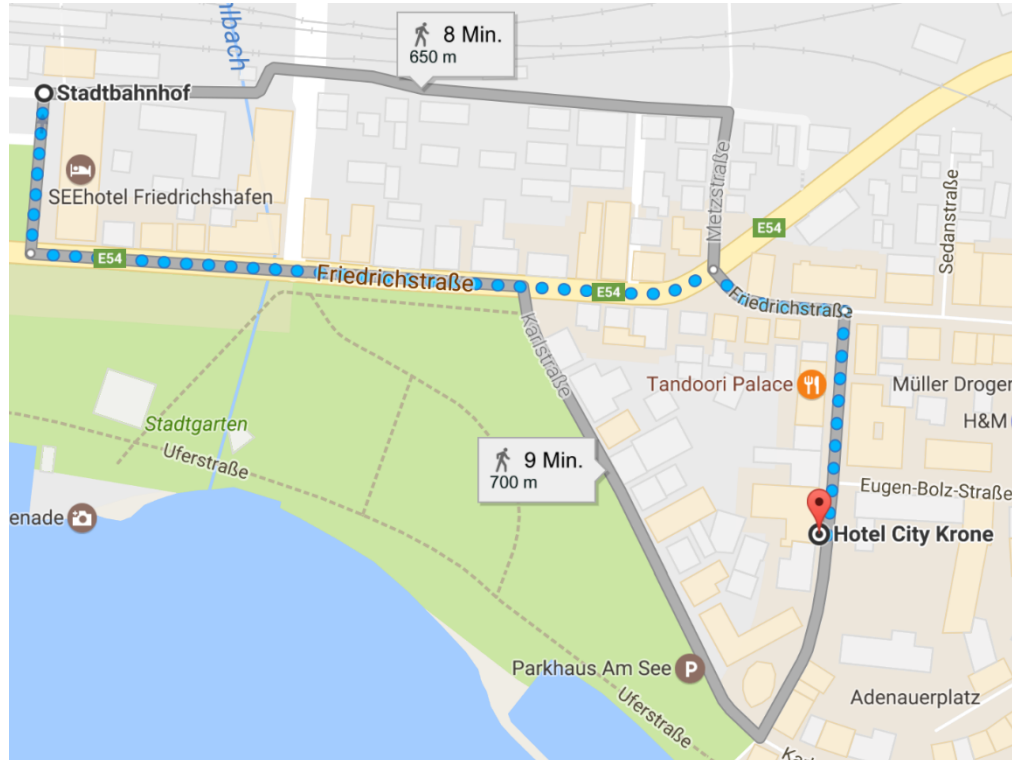
- | Continuing from FN central station the Buchhorner Hof lies within 3 minutes walking distance, just follow the main street next to the lake



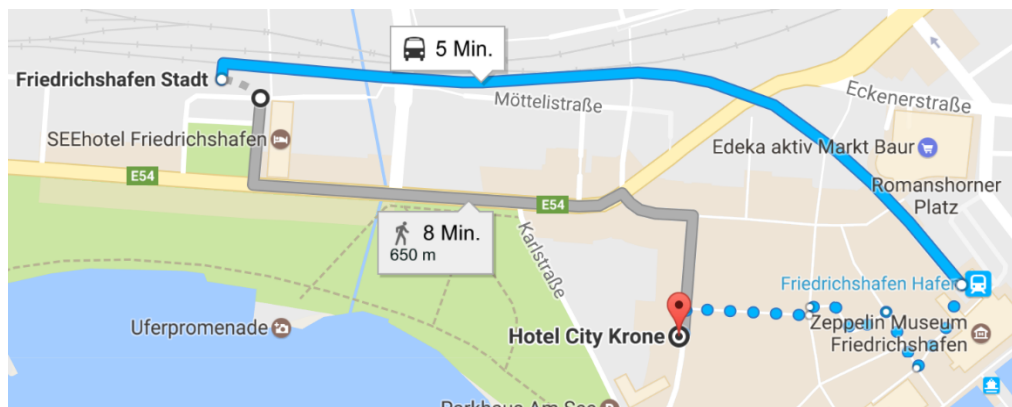
Hotel City Krone

Either by tram or by walking

| Walking should take about 10 minutes



| Tram RB 26775 to the station *Friedrichshafen Hafen* continuing you have to walk for approximately 4 minutes



| Taxis are waiting outside of the airport all day long. Travelling from FDH into the city center costs around 15 €, depending on the amount of traffic.

| Car rentals are located at the airport

Arrival via Munich Airport

- | “Fernbus“ (a bus for longer distances / alternative to travelling by train)
Direct Connections from Munich ZOB to Friedrichshafen Main Station (*Stadtbahn*) cost approximately 10 €
First: travelling by tram from Munich Airport to *Munich ZOB* (travel time around 45 minutes)
Travel time: 2 to 3 hours
Possible provider are meinfernbus / flixbus / deinbus
 - | Proceeding from the *Stadtbahn* as described above
- | Trains are heading regularly from Munich to Friedrichshafen. Direct connections are not available (at least 2 changes), one ticket costs around 30 €
Travel time: 3 to 4 hours
Further details about connections: homepage of Deutsche Bahn
- | Travelling by taxi or airport transfer, because of the distance rather expensive
Taxis are available at the airport or airport transfers can be booked early
Travel time: 2 to 3 hours
- | Car rentals are located at the airport
Travel time: 2 to 3 hours

Arrival via Zurich Airport (Switzerland)

- | Trains are heading regularly from Zurich Airport to Friedrichshafen. Direct connections are not available (at least 2 changes), one ticket costs around 40 €
Travel time: around 2 hours
Further details about connections: homepage of Deutsche Bahn
- | Taxis are available at the airport
Zurich is in Switzerland and therefore at the opposite side of Lake Constance.
Crossing by car ferry may be required
Travel time: 1 to 2 hours
- | “Fernbus“

Direct Connections from Zurich HB to Friedrichshafen

Main Station (*Stadtbahn*hof) cost about 10 to 14 €

First: travelling by tram from Zurich Airport to *Zurich HB*

Travel time: 2 to 3 hours

Possible provider are meinfernbus / flixbus / deinbus

| Proceeding from the *Stadtbahn*hof as described above

| Car rentals are located at the airport

Buchhorner Hof to Zeppelin University

Campus Fallenbrunnen

Bus:

Take either Bus 9 / 10 or 12 from *Friedrichshafen Stadtbahnhof* to *Fallenbrunnen Sued* (same buses for the return to the hotel)

Travel time: approximately 8 to 10 minutes

Bus fee: 2.10 €

The campus of Zeppelin University lies within walking distance (approximately 4 minutes)



Taxi:

Taxis should be waiting in front of the main station *Stadtbahnhof* all day long

Travel time: 8 to 10 minutes

Taxi fee: around 10 to 20 € (depending on the amount of traffic)

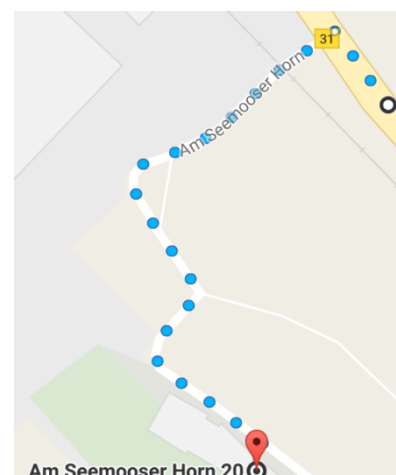
Bus:

Take the Bus 7395 which goes every half hour from *Friedrichshafen Stadtbahnhof* to *Zeppelin Universitaet Seemooser Horn* (Bus 7395 or 7394 to travel back to the *Stadtbahnhof*)

Travel time: approximazely 6 minutes

Bus fee: 2.10 €

The campus of Zeppelin University lies within walking distance (approximately 6 minutes)



| Taxi:

Taxis should be waiting in front of the main station *Stadtbahnhof* all day long

Travel time: 6 to 10 minutes

Taxi fee: around 10 to 15 € (depending on the amount of traffic)

Hotel City Krone to Zeppelin University**Campus Fallenbrunnen****| Bus:**

1. Take either Bus 9 / 10 or 12 from *Friedrichshafen Stadtbahnhof* to *Fallenbrunnen Sued* (same buses for the return to the hotel)

Travel time: approximately 8 to 10 minutes

2. Take either Bus 9 or 10 from *Hafenbahnhof Friedrichshafen* to *Fallenbrunnen Sued* (same buses for the return to the hotel)

Travel time: approximately 15 minutes

Walking from *Fallenbrunnen Sued* to Zeppelin University as well as walking from the hotel to the *Stadtbahnhof* or *Hafenbahnhof* are described above.

Bus fee: 2.10 €

Hafenbahnhof Friedrichshafen to Zeppelin Universitaet Seemooser Horn
(Bus 7395 or 7394 to travel back to the *Hafenbahnhof*)
Travel time: approximately 10 minutes

Walking from *Zeppelin Universitaet Seemooser Horn* to Zeppelin University as well as walking from the hotel to the *Stadtbahnhof* or *Hafenbahnhof* are described above.

Sightseeing in Friedrichshafen

The Schlosskirche (palace church) and the Schloss (palace)

The church with its two 55m high domed towers is the landmark of Friedrichshafen. It was built by Christian Thumb from 1695 to 1701 and has been a protestan church ever since. The palace was originally built as a Benedictine monastery in 1654, but it lost its status as a monastery during the process of secularisation. It was then converted to a royal summer residence for the Württemberg kings from 1824 to 1828. Today it is the residence of Friedrich Herzog (Duke) of Württemberg and closed to the public. However, it is possible to visit the vinothek and enter the property. (Opening hours vinothek: Tue to Fri 2pm – 6pm and Sat 10am – 1pm)

Zeppelin Museum Friedrichshafen

Situated in the historic harbour station building, this museum presents the world's largest collection on the subject of airship history, construction and travel. In the listed Bauhaus architecture of the Zeppelin Museum, there are about 1500 exhibits to discover, amongst which is the reconstruction of parts of the LZ 129 Hindenburg in its original size. The museum also offers a huge art collection representing some of the greatest German artists, such as Max Ackermann, Otto Dix and Erich Heckel.

Nikolaus church

The church was first mentioned as a chapel in 1325. The church was destroyed in 1944 and rebuilt from 1946 until 1949. Today it decorates the market square (Adenauerplatz) across from the town hall.

Lake Constance Trail and nature reserve center

On illustrated signs in the Eriskircher Ried, the largest nature reserve at the northern shore, and along Friedrichshafen lakeside promenade, walkers can find out more about the flora and fauna of the Lake Constance area.
